TRAINEE ACTIVITY

VALLI's Trainee Activity unite the young, the old and employees working with seniors. It offers youth successful experiences from the work world and supports them towards their individual studies and working life.

In Trainee, bridges are built between young people and senior citizens. At the same time, these operations respond to several societal challenges and increase the atmosphere of caring in society.

Nationwide Trainee Activity is implemented in co-operation with those guiding the young as well as in work communities engaged with seniors. These activities started in 2013 and we have managed to help several hundred young people move on with their lives and interests

TRAINEE PROGRAMME

Work experience and self-confidence – towards an individual future

These operations are intended for those aged 18–29 who are Not in Education, Employment, or Training (NEET).

The Trainee programme generally lasts four weeks, and during that time the young person is part of a work community.

The group of young people, supported by an instructor, get to know seniors and the various tasks associated with gerontological work.

Young people practise the skills needed in working life and studies with the continued support of a personal instructor and work community. This helps young people in planning their future.

TRAINEE RESULTS

The working life skills of all young people were strengthened during the Trainee operations.

After the end of the Trainee programme, 90% of the youth involved proceed further with their employment and study paths, and 70% go into the social and health services field.



CO-OPERATION

A professional who encounters young people

We increase knowledge in the area of a wide range of career options in the gerontological field as well as in the significance of connections between the generations.

We are implementing Trainee programs, workshops and campaigns to help young people learn to identify their own strengths in working life and to receive support for their own future study and career choices.

Educational institution representative

We tell them about multiple career choices in the social and health care sector as well as in gerontology and related fields. We attend lessons and design content with you. Teachers doing preparatory (TUVA) training for degree-based education or teaching in the field of social and health care: would this be of interest to you?

Senior work community

Encounters between the generations enriches the daily life of all partners and bring joy to the entire elderly care work community. We also strengthen the ability of work communities to meet and guide young people from various backgrounds in working life.
